


How to: Finish a Colour

To make your tapestry look neat and finished, weft ends need to be to the back of the tapestry so that they are not visible.

1. To achieve a non-visible weft tail when finishing a colour on the last warp, the weft needs to brought back over the top of the last warp and tucked behind the last warp, below the last row of weaving.



2. When finishing a colour mid-row of weaving, the same rules apply. Make sure the end gets tucked underneath the last row of weaving.

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
